Abstract: Defines "interrogation" and requires the La. Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to notify the officer being interrogated of the identity of the interrogator and the specific charges or violations being investigated.

Present law provides certain standards of investigating law enforcement officers and provides relative to the rights of such officers.

Proposed law retains present law and requires the agency conducting the investigation of an officer to notify the officer of the identity of the person conducting an interrogation, as well as the charges or violations being investigated.

Proposed law defines "interrogation" and makes technical changes.
