21 grandchildren, and she was blessed to live long enough to meet her first great-grandchild,

1 Emrie George, ten months before her passing; her great-grandchild was a true blessing that
2 brought much joy and laughter to her life; and

3 WHEREAS, Jane Couvillion is survived by her beloved children, Darren Couvillion
4 (Leah), Sue Andrepont (Chuck), Michelle George (Mike), and Jeanelle Fruge (Nick);
5 grandchildren, Peyton Couvillion, John Christian Lyons, Nathan Andrepont, Jacob George,
6 Ian George, Kaleb George, Grace Fruge, and Zachary Fruge; great-grandchild, Emrie
7 George; and a host of extended relatives and dear friends; she will be deeply missed, but the
