Proposed law allows a trade association that meets certain requirements to bring a civil action or intervene in a civil action in its own name or on behalf of one or more of its members for declaratory or injunctive relief.

Proposed law provides that a prevailing trade association may be granted any of the following remedies: declaratory relief, injunctive relief, and reasonable costs and attorney fees.

Proposed law provides that a civil action pursuant to proposed law may be brought before the commission or in any district court of competent jurisdiction.
