DISTRICT ATTORNEYS/ASST RE +\$7,572,420 GF EX See Note Page 1 of 1  
 Provides for an increase in the dollar amount in warrants to provide for the salaries of assistant district attorneys

Current law provides that, effective 7/01/21, assistant district attorneys statewide are to receive an annual salary of \$50,000 payable monthly. Proposed law increases the salary of the assistant district attorneys (624) to \$60,000 beginning 7/01/26; increases the salary of district attorneys (42) to \$65,000 beginning 07/01/26; is effective when an Act of the legislature containing a specific appropriation of monies for its implementation becomes effective.

**EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

Proposed law will result in an increase of \$7.6 M in SGF expenditures in FY 27 and subsequent fiscal years for annual salary increases for 624 assistant district attorneys (ADAs) and 42 district attorneys (DAs) throughout the state. The corresponding increase is associated with an increase in salaries (\$6,660,000) and related benefits (\$912,420) as follows:
