

**HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS****HB 675****2026 Regular Session****Riser**

HIGHWAYS: Designates a portion of United States Highway 425 in Franklin Parish as the "Assistant Chief Bill 'Putt' Linder Memorial Highway"

**Synopsis of Senate Amendments**

1. Adds the "Sheriff William Earl Hilton Memorial Highway" designation for a portion of Louisiana Highway 121 in Rapides Parish.
2. Adds the "Katy Wells Memorial Crossing Corridor" designation for a portion of Louisiana Highway 16 in Livingston Parish.
3. Makes proposed law effective upon signature of the governor.
4. Makes technical changes.

**Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate**

Designates a portion of U.S. Hwy. 425 from Morgan St. to La. Hwy. 913 in Franklin Parish as the "Assistant Chief Bill 'Putt' Linder Memorial Highway".

Designates a portion of La. Hwy. 121 from the intersection of La. Hwy. 112 in Hinston, La. to La. Hwy. 28 in Gardner, La. as the "Sheriff William Earl Hilton Memorial Highway".

Designates a portion of La. Hwy. 16 at Seventh Ward Elementary School Zone in Livingston Parish as the "Katy Wells Memorial Crossing Corridor".

Directs the Dept. of Transportation and Development (DOTD) to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting this highway designation provided local or private monies are received by the DOTD equal to its actual costs for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of the signage, not to exceed the sum of \$2,250 per sign for interstate routes and \$750 per sign for non-interstate routes.
