Provides for changes to the Water Sector Program. (gov sig)

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Proposed law removes the Office of Facility Planning and Control from the administration of the Water Sector Program, provides for a limited fiscal administrator or receivership, provides for deadlines, authorizes the commission to rescind any grant if a recipient fails to comply with rate study requirements, and allows the Water Sector Commission to approve modifications to the scope of work of the original grant award.
