PHARMACEUTICALS. Requests a legislative auditor report on opioid settlement fund expenditures.

SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

1. Provides for the legislative auditor to submit report to legislative no later than 30 days prior to start of 2027 Regular Session.
2. Clarifies information to be included in auditor's report.

Requests a Louisiana Legislative Auditor's report on opioid settlement fund expenditures no later than 30 days prior to the start of the 2027 Regular Session.

Requires the this report include the following:

- (1) The total amount of opioid settlement funds received to date.
- (2) The total amount of allocations distributed to each parish and sheriff's office.
- (3) An accounting of expenditures by each parish and sheriff's office according to the expenditures' purpose along the categories of treatment, prevention, and other strategies.
- (4) The established basis used to classify spending as "treatment", "prevention", or "other strategies" according to the approved purpose of such allocations.
- (5) The outcome or performance metrics tied to each expenditures where length of implementation or nature of expenditure lends to such measurement.
- (6) The reporting compliance status of each recipient as outlined in the MOU.
- (7) Unspent balances and anticipated future allocations.
- (8) Administrative costs, including staffing and contracts.
- (9) Identified barriers to reporting, oversight, or timely spending.

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
