

HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS**HB 746****2026 Regular Session****Owen**

LOCAL GOVERNMENT: Provides relative to oversized trucking permits issued by local governments

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Removes a provision that prohibited political subdivisions from adopting new permit requirements for oversized vehicles during a one-year moratorium established by proposed law to allow for a clarification that during the moratorium political subdivisions may continue issuing permits under existing requirements.
2. Makes technical changes.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Present law requires oversized vehicles or combination of vehicles that do not meet the requirements of present law obtain a special permit when using public highways of the state. Further specifies that the Dept. of Transportation and Development (DOTD) be the entity to issue special permits. Further authorizes any other agencies or departments of the state or political subdivisions to issue other special permits.

Proposed law prohibits any special permit outside of the permits required by the DOTD.

Proposed law establishes a one-year moratorium on the issuance of local permits for oversized vehicles. Proposed law prohibits political subdivisions from adopting new permit requirements but allows for the continued issuance of permits under existing requirements.

Effective upon the signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
