

HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS**HB 475****2026 Regular Session****Berault**

HEALTH CARE/PROVIDERS: Requires a healthcare provider to obtain a patient's consent prior to recording a medical visit

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Allows a professional board to discipline a healthcare professional who violates proposed law.
2. Establishes civil immunity for a healthcare profession who violates proposed law absent gross negligence or willful misconduct.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Proposed law requires a healthcare professional licensed under present law to disclose to a patient, prior to an appointment or treatment, the use of any recording device, software, or service that utilizes artificial intelligence to transcribe communications between the professional and the patient.

Proposed law further provides that a professional licensing board may discipline a healthcare professional who violates proposed law.

Proposed law provides that a healthcare professional who violates proposed law is immune from civil liability in the absence of gross negligence or willful misconduct.
