

**HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS**

CIVIL/VENUE: Provides for venue with respect to the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System

**Synopsis of Senate Amendments**

1. Requires action to be brought in East Baton Rouge Parish or in the parish of the domicile of the retirement system or employee benefit program when the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System or its board of trustees is the defendant.
2. Requires action to be brought only in the district court having jurisdiction in the parish where the cause of action arises when the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System or its board of trustees is the plaintiff.
3. Makes technical changes.

**Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate**

Present law (C.C.P. Art. 84) requires actions involving the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System ("MPERS") to be brought in the parish of East Baton Rouge ("EBRP") or in the parish of the domicile of the retirement system or employee benefit program.

Proposed law amends present law to require action to be brought in EBRP or in the parish of the domicile of the retirement system or employee benefit program when the MPERS or its board of trustees is the defendant.

Proposed law further requires an action to be brought only in the district court having jurisdiction in the parish in which the cause of action arises when the MPERS or its board of trustees is the plaintiff.
