PROPERTY/PUBLIC: Provides relative to the selling of state-owned surplus movable property

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Requires that the preference for in-state auctioneers apply to auctions conducted in public and by internet sale.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Present law authorizes the commissioner of administration to sell state-owned surplus movable property at public auction. Authorizes the commissioner of administration to hire qualified licensed auctioneers to handle the sale.

Proposed law gives a preference for an in-state auctioneer over an out-of-state auctioneer where services provided are equal in quality and do not exceed in cost by more than 10% of services available from out-of-state auctioneers. The preference applies to auctions held at public auction and by internet sale.
