

HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS**HB 593****2026 Regular Session****Chance Henry**

MTR VEHICLE/OFFICE: Increases the maximum service and transaction fee a governing authority may assess to fund an office of motor vehicles field office not fully funded by the state

Synopsis of Senate Amendments	
1.	Codifies the fee exemption provision applicable to office of motor vehicles field offices located in Shreveport.
2.	Makes technical changes.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Present law allows local governments to implement a fee for each service or transaction carried out at an office of motor vehicles field office that is not fully funded by the state.

Present law limits this fee to \$4.50 per transaction, except for Orleans, Jefferson and Calcasieu parishes which may charge up to \$6, and the city of West Monroe which may charge up to \$8. Present law mandates that revenue generated from these fees be used for facility rental, utilities, and maintenance. Present law prohibits charging a fee for the acquisition or renewal of a motor vehicle registration license.

Proposed law increases the maximum local service and transaction fee amount in present law from \$4.50 to \$8 statewide. Also removes the authority granted to Orleans, Jefferson, Calcasieu, and West Monroe parishes regarding maximum service and transaction fees.

Proposed law provides an exemption for office of motor vehicle field offices in Shreveport, La.
