1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 32:403.3(B)(2)(c), relative to motor vehicle traffic stops; to require the
3 Department of Public Safety and Corrections to create specially designed envelopes
4 for individuals with certain disorders and disabilities; to improve traffic stop
5 interactions; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 32:403.3(B)(2)(c) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

8 §403.3. Identification stickers and decals; deaf and hard of hearing; autism spectrum
9 disorder; mental, physical, or developmental disability

15 (c) The Department of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor
16 vehicles, may create specially designed envelopes to be provided to drivers with
17 mental, physical, developmental disabilities, or autism spectrum disorder or their

19 Section. The envelopes may include guidelines to assist law enforcement officers
