RETIREMENT/FIREFIGHTERS: Prohibits certain post-divorce earnable compensation from being included in a former spouse's portion of community property

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Provides relative to the earnable compensation of a full-time firefighter instead of the earnable compensation of a member of the Firefighters' Retirement System.
2. Makes technical changes.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Present law (R.S. 9:2801) provides requirements for the court to partition community property and settle claims arising from matrimonial regimes and co-ownership of former community property.

Proposed law retains present law and further provides that any increase in a full-time firefighter's earnable compensation that occurs following termination of a community of acquets and gains and that was conditional on the full-time firefighter's passage of both a written examination and a working test shall not be included in the calculation of a former spouse's portion of community property.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
