ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE PERMT: Provides relative to limitations on the issuance of certain alcoholic beverage permits

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Changes the ending date of the moratorium on the issuance of permits for the sale of high alcoholic beverages within the boundaries of District 3 of the La. House of Representatives from December 31, 2026 to December 31, 2027.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Present law provides for the issuance and regulation of various high and low alcoholic beverage permits.

Present law prohibits additional issuance of permits for the sale of high or low alcoholic beverages within the boundaries of District 3 of the La. House of Representatives from Aug. 1, 2025, through Dec. 31, 2026.

Proposed law retains present law prohibition but changes the ending date of the moratorium on the issuance of permits for the sale of *high* alcoholic beverages within the boundaries of District 3 of the La. House of Representatives from December 31, 2026 to December 31, 2027.

Proposed law changes the ending date of the moratorium on the issuance of permits for the sale of *low* alcoholic beverages within the boundaries of District 3 of the La. House of Representatives from December 31, 2026 to December 31, 2032.

Proposed law provides for an exception for national chain restaurants or stores. Further defines "national chain" as a company that operates in 10 or more states.
