Prior law provided that producers of low-risk, homemade foods may sell certain foods to the public and are exempt from food safety and sanitary requirements if the producer sells less than \$30,000 of low-risk, homemade foods annually.

New law increases the gross annual sales limit for this exemption from \$30,000 to \$100,000, after which a producer would no longer qualify for the exemption.

Effective August 1, 2026.
