ACT 583 (HB 1103)

Existing law provides relative to the regulation of construction or improvement of industrial facilities.

Existing law provides that, excluding the applicable requirements of the International Plumbing Code, the provisions of existing law shall not apply to the construction or improvement inside the secured or fenced confines of certain industrial facilities that are engaged in certain activities.

New law includes 334511 search, detection, navigation, guidance, aeronautical, and nautical system and instrument manufacturing in the list of industrial facilities and activities outlined in existing law.

Existing law provides relative to the regulation of construction by local governments.

New law adds that notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, no political subdivision shall require a building permit for, apply the provisions of a building code to, or otherwise regulate pursuant to new and existing law, the construction or improvement inside the secured or fenced confines of the industrial facilities exempted in new law.

Effective upon signature of governor (June 1, 2026).
