VITAL STATS/BIRTH CERT: Provides for a certificate of stillbirth

1	AN ACT
2	To enact Part VI of Chapter 2 of Title 40 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of
3	1950, to be comprised of R.S. 40:91 through 94, relative to birth
4	certificates; to provide for the issuance of certificates of stillbirth; to
5	provide for delayed certificates of stillbirth; to provide for certified
6	copies and fees; and to provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. Part VI of Chapter 2 of Title 40 of the Louisiana Revised
9	Statutes of 1950, comprised of R.S. 40:91 through 94, is hereby enacted to

13	This Part may be known and referred to as the "Missing Angels

16	A. In addition to the requirements in R.S. 40:47 and 49, the state
17	registrar shall establish a certificate of stillbirth on a form approved by

1	the state registrar for each spontaneous fetal death which occurs in this
2	state after twenty complete weeks of gestation or more, calculated from
3	the date the last normal menstrual period began to the date of delivery,
4	or a weight of three hundred fifty grams or more. This certificate may
5	be requested by the parent or parents of a stillborn child.
6	B. The certificate of stillbirth shall meet all of the requirements
7	of R.S. 40:34 and 45 relating to the contents and preparation of a birth
8	certificate. However, if the parent or parents of the child do not wish
9	to provide a name for the stillborn child, the preparer shall leave blank
10	the space for the full name of the child.
11	C. The certificate of stillbirth shall be filed with the designated
12	registrar within five days following the delivery and prior to interment,
13	cremation, removal, or other disposition of the fetus.

Abstract: Enacts the "Missing Angels Act".

<u>Present law</u> provides for the preparation and filing of spontaneous fetal death certificates for stillborn babies.

<u>Proposed law</u> maintains <u>present law</u> and additionally allows the parent or parents of a stillborn baby to request the issuance of a certificate of stillbirth.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the certificate of stillbirth to meet all the requirements of form, preparation, disclosure, evidence, issuance, copies, and fees for birth certificates.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the filing of delayed certificates of stillbirth in accordance with DHH regulations.
