HOUSE BILL NO. 1692

BY REPRESENTATIVES TRICHE, FAUCHEUX, AND HEATON

FISHING: Designates the spotted sea trout as the official state saltwater fish

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 49:170.6, relative to state symbols; to designate the spotted sea
3 trout (*Cynoscion nebulosus*) as the official state saltwater fish; and to
4 provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 49:170.6 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §170.6. State saltwater fish

8 There shall be an official state saltwater fish. The official state
9 saltwater fish shall be the spotted sea trout, or speckled trout
10 (*Cynoscion nebulosus*). Its use on the official documents of the state
11 and with the insignia of the state is hereby authorized.
