AN ACT

To enact R.S. 49:170.6, relative to state symbols; to designate the spotted sea trout (Cynoscion nebulosus) as the official state saltwater fish; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 49:170.6 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§170.6. State saltwater fish

There shall be an official state saltwater fish. The official state saltwater fish shall be the spotted sea trout, or speckled trout (Cynoscion nebulosus). Its use on the official documents of the state and with the insignia of the state is hereby authorized.
