## 1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

- 7 "(5) Prior to the distribution of the updated printed materials provided for in Paragraph (C)
- (1) of this Subsection, the Department of Health and Hospitals shall submit the updated 8 9
- printed materials to the Senate Committee on Health and Welfare and the House of 10 Representatives Committee on Health and Welfare for legislative oversight review pursuant
- 11 to the Administrative Procedure Act.
- 12 (6)(a) The Woman's Right to Know Advisory Committee, hereinafter "advisory committee,"
- is hereby created and shall be composed of the following members: 13
- (i) The secretary of the Department of Health and Hospitals or his designee. 14
- 15 (ii) A representative from Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center at New Orleans appointed by its chancellor. 16
- (iii) A representative from Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center at Shreveport 17 18 appointed by its chancellor.
- (iv) A representative from Tulane University Health Sciences Center appointed by its 19 20 chancellor.
- 21 (v) The president of the Women's Counseling Center of North Louisiana, Inc., or his 22 designee.
- 23 (vi) The director of Planned Parenthood of Louisiana and the Mississippi Delta, Inc., or his 24 designee.
- 25 (vii) The director of the Louisiana Maternal and Child Health Coalition, or his designee.
- (viii) A representative of an abortion alternative group from the geographic area south of 26 27 Alexandria, Louisiana.
- 28 (b) One member shall be an anaesthesia specialist, one member shall be an obstetrics and 29 gynecology specialist, and one member shall be a medical ethics specialist.
- 30 (c) The duties and purpose of the advisory committee shall be to review and approve the
- 31 information related to the unborn child at the various gestational ages and make recommendations to the Department of Health and Hospitals regarding the content of the 32
- 33 materials published by the department. Such recommendations shall be objective,
- 34 nonjudgmental, and designed to convey only accurate scientific information about the 35 unborn child at the various gestational ages. All recommendations shall be made to the
- Department of Health and Hospitals by December thirty-first of each year. 36
- 37 (d) The advisory committee shall elect a chairman, vice chairman, and secretary at its first 38 meeting.
- 39 (e) The advisory committee shall meet at least twice each year or more frequently as
- 40 necessary. Meetings shall be called by the chairman; however, a majority of the members
- 41 of the advisory committee may call a meeting.
- 42 (f) Four members of the advisory committee shall constitute a quorum.
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
