LEGISLATORS. Provides for a pay raise for legislators. (7/1/08)

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 24:31, 31.1(A) and (E), 502(A), 504(B), 506(A), and 507(B),
3	relative to compensation of members of the legislature and per diem; to provide for
4	per diem during regular and extraordinary sessions; to provide for an increase in the
5	compensation paid to legislators; to provide for an increase in compensation paid to
6	the speaker of the House of Representatives and the president of the Senate; to
7	provide for an increase in the compensation paid to the speaker pro tempore of the
8	House of Representatives and the president pro tempore of the Senate; to provide for
9	an increase in compensation paid to the chairman of the Senate Finance Committee,
10	the chairman of the Senate Revenue and Fiscal Affairs Committee, the chairman of
11	the House Appropriations Committee, and the chairman of the House Ways and
12	Means Committee; and to provide for related matters.
13	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
14	Section 1. R.S. 24:31, 31.1(A) and (E), 502(A), 504(B), 506(A), and 507(B) are
15	hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
16	§31. Compensation of members
17	The compensation of the members of the legislature shall be equal to the rate

1	allowable for per diem deduction under Section 162(h)(1)(B)(ii) of Title 26 of the
2	United States Code for the location of the state capital during their attendance on that
3	body. This per diem shall apply only to service rendered during regular and
4	extraordinary sessions of the legislature.
5	§31.1. Salary for members; expense allowance; mileage allowance
6	A.(1) In addition to the per diem and all other allowances provided by law
7	for members of the Legislature of Louisiana, each member of the legislature, except
8	the president and the president pro tempore of the Senate, the chairman of the
9	Senate Finance Committee and the chairman of the Senate Revenue and Fiscal
10	Affairs Committee, and the speaker and the speaker pro tempore of the House of
11	Representatives, the chairman of the House Appropriations Committee and the
12	chairman of the House Ways and Means Committee, shall be paid a salary in the
13	full sum of sixteen thousand eight hundred dollars per annum thirty percent of the
14	annual salary for members of the United States Congress. Such salary shall be
15	adjusted as necessary effective July first annually. This salary shall be
16	compensation for service to the House of Representatives or the Senate, as
17	appropriate, including that rendered during regular and extraordinary sessions
18	of the legislature and during the interim between sessions.
19	(2) The salary of the chairman of the Senate Finance Committee, the
20	chairman of the Senate Revenue and Fiscal Affairs Committee, the chairman
21	of the House Appropriations Committee, and the chairman of the House Ways

2 22 and Means Committee shall be thirty-five percent of the annual salary for 23 members of the United States Congress. Such salary shall be adjusted as necessary effective July first annually. This salary shall be compensation to the 24 25 chairman of the Senate Finance Committee, the chairman of the Senate Revenue and Fiscal Affairs Committee, the chairman of the House 26 27 Appropriations Committee, and the chairman of the House Ways and Means Committee for service to the Senate, including that rendered during regular and 28 29 extraordinary sessions of the legislature and during the interim between

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1	sessions. The salary provided for in this Paragraph shall be payable in the same
2	manner as provided in R.S. 24:31.1(B). The chairmen of the Senate Finance
3	Committee and the Senate Revenue and Fiscal Affairs Committee shall be
4	entitled to the per diem and all other allowances provided by law for members
5	of the Legislature of Louisiana.

7	E. In addition to the salary, compensation, and all other allowances provided
8	by law for members of the legislature, each member of the legislature shall be paid
9	a monthly expense allowance, as referred to in R.S. 11:403(10), in the amount of five
10	hundred one thousand dollars per month for expenses in connection with the
11	holding or conduct of their office. Warrants for the payment of such allowance shall
12	be in accordance with, and subject to, Subsection B.

14	§502. Speaker of the House of Representatives; salary; expenses
15	A. The <u>annual</u> salary of the speaker of the House of Representatives shall
16	be thirty-two thousand dollars per annum forty-five percent of the annual salary
17	for members of the United States Congress, such salary to be payable monthly on
18	his own warrant and drawn on the general fund of the state. This Such salary shall
19	be adjusted as necessary effective July first annually. Subject to Subsection B,
20	this salary shall be compensation to the speaker for service to the House of
21	Representatives, including that rendered during regular and extraordinary sessions
22	of the legislature and during the interim between sessions.

24	§504. Speaker pro tempore; assumption of duties of speaker; salary
25	A. * * *
26	B. The annual salary of the speaker pro tempore of the House of
27	Representatives shall be twenty-four thousand five hundred dollars per annum
28	thirty-five percent of the annual salary for members of the United States
29	Congress. Such salary shall be adjusted as necessary effective July first

2	to the House of Representatives, including that rendered during regular and

5	provided in R.S. 24:31.1(B). The speaker pro tempore shall be entitled to the per
6	diem and all other allowances provided by law for members of the Legislature of

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§506. President of the Senate; salary; expenses

A. The **annual** salary of the president of the Senate shall be thirty-two 10 11 thousand dollars per annum forty-five percent of the annual salary for members 12 of the United States Congress, such salary to be payable monthly on his own 13 warrant and drawn on the general fund of the state. This Such salary shall be adjusted as necessary effective July first annually. Subject to Subsection B, this 14 salary shall be compensation to the president for service to the Senate, including that 15 16 rendered during regular and extraordinary sessions of the legislature and during the interim between sessions. 17

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§507. President pro tempore; assumption of duties of president; salary

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21 B. The **annual** salary of the president pro tempore of the Senate shall be twenty-four thousand five hundred dollars per annum thirty-five percent of the 22 annual salary for members of the United States Congress. Such salary shall be 23 adjusted as necessary effective July first annually. This salary shall be 24 compensation to the president pro tempore for service to the Senate, including that 25 rendered during regular and extraordinary sessions of the legislature and during the 26 27 interim between sessions. The salary provided for in this Section shall be payable in the same manner as provided in R.S. 24:31.1(B). The president pro tempore shall 28 29 be entitled to the per diem and all other allowances provided by law for members of

Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2008.

DIGEST

Duplessis (SB 672)

<u>Present law</u> provides that legislators shall be paid a per diem equal to the rate allowable for per diem deduction under the Federal Tax Code for the location of the state capital during their attendance. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but provides that this per diem shall only be paid during regular and special sessions, and not during the interim.

<u>Present law</u> provides that in addition to the per diem and all other allowances, members of the legislature shall be paid an annual salary of \$16,800.

<u>Proposed law</u> revises the salary of members of the legislature, as follows:

The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House shall be paid 45% of the annual salary for members of the U.S. Congress. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker Pro Tempore of the House shall be paid 35% of the annual salary for members of the U.S. Congress.

The salary of the chairman of the Senate Finance Committee, the Senate Revenue and Fiscal Affairs Committee, the House Appropriations Committee, and the House Ways and Means Committee shall be 35% of the annual salary for members of the U.S. Congress. The chairmen of Senate Finance and Revenue and Fiscal Affairs shall be entitled to per diem and other allowances provided by law for members of the legislature.

All other members of the legislature shall be paid 30% of the annual salary for members of the U.S. Congress.

All salaries shall be adjusted as necessary effective July 1 annually.

<u>Present law</u> provides that in additional to a salary and other allowances, a legislator shall be paid a monthly expense allowance for expenses in connection with holding or conducting their office in the amount of \$500 per month.

Proposed law increases the monthly expense allowance to \$1,000 for each member.

Effective July 1, 2008.

(Amends R.S. 24:31, 31.1(A) and (E), 502(A), 504(B), 506(A), and 507(B))

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Finance to the original <u>bill.</u>

1. Revises salary of membership of the legislature, as follows:

Page 5 of 6

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The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House shall be paid 45% of the annual salary for members of the U.S. Congress. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker Pro Tempore of the House shall be paid 35% of the annual salary for members of the U.S. Congress.

The salary of the chairman of the Senate Finance Committee, the Senate Revenue and Fiscal Affairs Committee, the House Appropriations Committee, and the House Ways and Means Committee shall be 35% of the annual salary for members of the U.S. Congress. The chairmen of Senate Finance and Revenue and Fiscal Affairs shall be entitled to per diem and other allowances provided by law for members of the legislature.

All other members of the legislature shall be paid 30% of the annual salary for members of the U.S. Congress.

All salaries shall be adjusted as necessary effective July 1 annually.

- 2. Increases each member's monthly expense allowance from \$500 per month to \$1,000 per month.
- 3. Makes effective July 1, 2008.
