Beginning on July 1, 2009, and annually thereafter, if there has been an increase in the Consumer Price Index for all urban consumers (CPI-U), as prepared by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics in the preceding calendar year, the salary shall be adjusted by the same percentage as the increase in that CPI-U rounded to the nearest whole dollar.
