10 §28. Uniform compulsive and problem gambling identification and treatment
11 program

12 A. The Louisiana Gaming Control Board shall adopt rules
13 establishing a uniform compulsive and problem gambling identification
14 and treatment program.

15 B. The uniform compulsive and problem gambling
16 identification and treatment program shall provide that the holder of
17 any license issued by the board for the conducting of gaming activities
18 as provided by law shall implement the policies and procedures which
19 are adopted by the board and are designed to:

20 (1) Identify problem gamblers.

21 (2) Prevent previously identified problem gamblers from
22 gambling at the licensee's facility or other facilities licensed by the state
23 of Louisiana.

24 C. The policies and procedures shall be developed in
25 cooperation with the office of alcohol and drug abuse for the
26 Department of Health and Hospitals as provided in R.S. 28:841 and
27 shall include the following:

28 (1) Training of key employees to identify and report suspected
29 problem gamblers.

30 (2) Procedures for recording and tracking identified problem
31 gamblers.

1 (3) Policies designed to prevent serving alcohol to intoxicated
2 gaming patrons.

3 (4) Steps for removing problem gamblers from the licensed
4 establishment or facility.

5 (5) Procedures for preventing re-entry of problem gamblers.

6 D. All rules adopted pursuant to the provisions of this Section
7 shall be adopted in accordance with the provisions of the
8 Administrative Procedure Act and R.S. 27:15(B)(8).

9 E. Nothing herein shall be construed to relieve the licensee from
10 the requirements of posting of signs to inform customers of the toll-free
11 telephone number available to provide information and referral services
12 regarding compulsive or problem gambling as required by R.S.
13 27:58(10), 249(B), 320, or 377.
