Uniform compulsive and problem gambling identification and treatment program  A. The Louisiana Gaming Control Board shall adopt rules establishing a uniform compulsive and problem gambling identification and treatment program.  B. The uniform compulsive and problem gambling identification and treatment program shall provide that the holder of any license issued by the board for the conducting of gaming activities as provided by law shall implement the policies and procedures which are adopted by the board and are designed to:  (1) Identify problem gamblers.  (2) Prevent previously identified problem gamblers from gambling at the licensee's facility or other facilities licensed by the state of Louisiana.  C. The policies and procedures shall be developed in cooperation with the office of alcohol and drug abuse for the Department of Health and Hospitals as provided in R.S. 28:841 and shall include the following:  (1) Training of key employees to identify and report suspected problem gamblers.	1	AMENDMENT NO. 1
