DIGEST

<u>Proposed law</u> adds NBA basketball teams to the list of basic industries qualifying for benefits under Quality Jobs Program.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that such team must be located in Louisiana and have entered into a contract with the state prior to Nov. 1, 2003, to qualify.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that contracts between the state and pro basketball team shall not provide a total tax credit of more than \$3,650,000 in a taxable year and shall not allow persons owing more than 25% of such team to be included in gross payroll to calculate the amount of the tax credit.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that subsequent to Nov. 1, 2003, the contract may be renewed.

Effective July 1, 2002.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

<u>Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Revenue</u> and Fiscal Affairs to the engrossed bill.

- 1. Adds NBA teams to qualify for benefits under the Quality Jobs Program.
- 2. Requires that such teams must be located in La. and have a contract with the state prior to Nov. 1, 2003, to qualify for the Quality Jobs Program.
- 3. Puts a \$3.65 million cap on tax credits allowed for basketball teams.
- 4. Allow contract renewals subsequent to Nov. 1, 2003, between the pro basketball team and the state.
