2 On page 1, line 12, delete "No official or court of the state of Louisiana shall"

4 On page 1, delete lines 13 through 15 in their entirety and on line 16, delete "marriage for
5 unmarried individuals shall not be valid or recognized."

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 In Senate Conforming Floor Amendment No. 8 proposed by the Senate and adopted by the
8 Senate on May 20, 2004, on line 24, delete "change the semicolon ";" to a comma "," and
9 insert "delete the semicolon ";"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 2, line 9, delete "that legal incidents of marriage shall not be"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 5

13 Delete Senate Conforming Floor Amendment No. 9 proposed by the Senate and adopted by
14 the Senate on May 20, 2004.

15 AMENDMENT NO. 6

16 On page 2, delete lines 10 through 14 in their entirety and insert the following:

17 "and that no official or court of the state of Louisiana shall recognize any marriage contracted
18 in any other jurisdiction which is not the union of one man and one woman. (Adds Article
19 XII, Section 15)"
