5 On page 1, delete lines 10 through 16 in their entirety and insert the following:

6 "<u>§27. Defense of Marriage</u>

Section 27. Marriage in the state of Louisiana shall consist only of the union of one man and one woman. No official or court of the state of Louisiana shall construe this constitution or any state law to require that marriage or the legal incidents thereof be conferred upon any member of a union other than the union of one man and one woman. A legal status identical or substantially similar to that of marriage for unmarried individuals shall not be valid or recognized. No official or court of the state of Louisiana shall recognize any marriage contracted in any other jurisdiction which is not the union of one man and one woman."

15 <u>AMENDMENT NO. 3</u>

On page 2, delete lines 5 through 10 in their entirety and insert the following:

"To provide that marriage in this state shall consist of the union of one man and one woman; to provide that legal incidents of marriage shall not be conferred upon a union other than the union of one man and one woman; to provide that a legal status similar to marriage shall not be valid or recognized for unmarried individuals; to prohibit the recognition of any marriage contracted in another state which is not the union of one man and one woman. (Adds Article I, Section 27)"
