
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Judiciary to Original House Bill No. 763 by Representative Hunter

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, at the beginning of line 11, before "judges" delete "The" and insert
3 in lieu thereof "A. Respecting seniority and the requirement that all cases be
4 assigned randomly within multi-judge sections, the"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 2

6 On page 1, line 12, after "may" delete the remainder of the line in its entirety
7 and insert in lieu thereof "assign certain divisions of the court to a criminal
8 section and certain divisions to a civil, drug court, juvenile, or other section of
9 the court."

10 AMENDMENT NO. 3

11 On page 1, delete lines 13 and 14 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the
12 following:

13 "B. No rule adopted by the court may assign any division, without its
14 consent, to any section for a longer period than three years.

15 C. Notwithstanding any principal assignment to sections, all divisions
16 of the court shall retain general jurisdiction to hear all matters."
