<u>Existing law</u> provides for the preparation and filing of spontaneous fetal death certificates for stillborn babies.

<u>New law</u> provides that, upon the request of the parent or parents of the stillborn child, a certificate of stillbirth shall be issued.

<u>New law</u> requires the certificate of stillbirth to meet all the requirements of form, preparation, disclosure, evidence, issuance, copies, and fees for birth certificates as stipulated in R.S. 40:40 and R.S. 40:44.

<u>New law</u> authorizes the filing of delayed certificates of stillbirth in accordance with DHH regulations.

New law provides that the certificate of stillbirth shall be identified as a certificate of birth resulting in stillbirth.
