
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Civil Law and Procedure to Original House Bill No. 1450 by Representative Fontenot

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, change "Article 89" to "Articles 89 and 3520"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 9, after "Code" and before "hereby" delete "Article 89 is" and
5 insert "Articles 89 and 3520 are"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 1, delete lines 13 through 17 in their entirety and insert the following:

8 "other. A purported marriage between persons of the same sex contracted in
9 another state shall be governed by the provisions of Title II of Book IV of the
10 Civil Code.

12 AMENDMENT NO. 4

13 On page 2, delete lines 1 and 2 in their entirety and insert the following:

14 "Art. 3520. Marriage

15 A. A marriage that is valid in the state where contracted, or in the state
16 where the parties were first domiciled as husband and wife, shall be treated as
17 a valid marriage unless to do so would violate a strong public policy of the
18 state whose law is applicable to the particular issue under Article 3519.

19 B. A purported marriage between persons of the same sex violates a
20 strong public policy of the state of Louisiana and such a marriage contracted
21 in another state shall not be recognized in this state for any purpose, including
22 the assertion of any right or claim as a result of the purported marriage."
