2	To amend and reenact Section 2 of Act No. 300, Section 2 of Act No. 516, Section 3 of Act
3	No. 594, Section 3 of Act No. 645, Section 3 of Act No. 667, Section 3 of Act No.
4	688, and Section 2 of Act No. 757, all of the 2008 Regular Session of the Louisiana
5	Legislature, relative to motor vehicles; to provide relative to driving; to provide
6	relative to traffic violations; to provide relative to penalties; and to provide for
7	related matters.
8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. Section 2 of Act No. 300 of the 2008 Regular Session of the Legislature
10	is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
11	Section 2. The provisions of this Act shall not become effective until the
12	implementation of the Next Generation Motor Vehicle project of the Department of
13	Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles, is finalized become effective
14	<u>on June 1, 2009</u> .
15	Section 2. Section 2 of Act No. 516 of the 2008 Regular Session of the Legislature
16	is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
17	Section 2. The provisions of this Act shall not become effective until the
18	implementation of the Next Generation Motor Vehicle Project of the Department of
19	Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles, is finalized become effective
20	on June 1, 2009.

2 governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on

3 June 1, 2009, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.

Abstract: Amends effective date provisions of Act Nos. 300, 516, 594, 645, 667, 688, and 757, all relative to motor vehicles, driving, and traffic violations.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the provisions of Act Nos. 300, 516, 594, 645, 667, 688, and 757 shall not become effective until the implementation of the Next Generation Motor Vehicle project of DPS&C, office of motor vehicles, is finalized.

<u>Proposed law</u> amends the effective date provisions of Act Nos. 300, 516, 594, 645, 688, and 757 all relative to motor vehicles, driving, and traffic violations, and provides that such Acts shall become effective on June 1, 2009.

<u>Proposed law</u> amends the effective date provision of Act No. 667, relative to the cell phone restrictions for first time issuance of a driver's license, to become effective on April 1, 2010.

Effective June 1, 2009.

Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Transportation, Highways</u> <u>and Public Works</u> to the <u>original</u> bill.

1. Changes the effective date provision of Act No. 667 of the 2008 Regular Session <u>from</u> June 1, 2009, to April 1, 2010.
