**Abstract:** Amends effective date provisions of Act Nos. 300, 516, 594, 645, 667, 688, and 757, all relative to motor vehicles, driving, and traffic violations.

Present law provides that the provisions of Act Nos. 300, 516, 594, 645, 667, 688, and 757 shall not become effective until the implementation of the Next Generation Motor Vehicle project of DPS&C, office of motor vehicles, is finalized.

Proposed law amends the effective date provisions of Act Nos. 300, 516, 594, 645, 688, and 757 all relative to motor vehicles, driving, and traffic violations, and provides that such Acts shall become effective on June 1, 2009.

Proposed law amends the effective date provision of Act No. 667, relative to the cell phone restrictions for first time issuance of a driver's license, to become effective on April 1, 2010.

Effective June 1, 2009.

(Amends §2 of Act No. 300, §2 of Act No. 516, §3 of Act No. 594, §3 of Act No. 645, §3 of Act No. 667, §3 of Act No. 688, and §2 of Act No. 757 of the 2008 R.S.)
