## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

The proposed legislation will have no net impact on total expenditures related to large and small urban transit systems. However, the various transit systems across the state will be impacted due to the change in the definition of operating revenue or income to include local support. The recipients affected by this legislation are listed below with the net impact:
