Richard HB No. 1390

**Abstract:** Changes the amount of the per diem for members of the legislature <u>from</u> the rate allowable for per diem deduction under federal law <u>to</u> \$159 per day.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 24:31) provides that the compensation of the members of the legislature shall be equal to the rate allowable for per diem deduction under federal law (Section 162(h)(1)(B)(ii) of Title 26 of the United States Code) for the location of the state capital during their attendance on that body.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes the amount of the per diem for members of the legislature <u>from</u> the rate allowable for per diem deduction under federal law <u>to</u> \$159 per day during their attendance on that body.
