HB No. 169

Abstract: Authorizes the use of sound suppressors when taking nongame nuisance quadrupeds.

Present law authorizes the taking of outlaw quadrupeds, nutria, or beaver at any time of year.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the use of a firearm fitted with a sound suppressor for such taking when the person taking the outlaw quadruped is authorized to possess such firearm fitted with a sound suppressor, as evidenced by possession of the federal tax stamp required by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives. Prohibits use of a sound suppressor by any person convicted of a hunting violation class four or greater for five years after the date of conviction.

Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Natural Resources and</u> <u>Environment</u> to the <u>original</u> bill.

1. Prohibits use of a sound suppressor by any person convicted of a hunting violation class four or greater for five years after the date of conviction.
