## 1 <u>AMENDMENT NO. 1</u>

- 2 On page 3, between lines 7 and 8 insert the following:
- 3 "(4) Any person, contractor, or employer who complies with the provisions of this
- 4 Section shall not be liable, either criminally or civilly, under state law for the hiring of
- 5 an unauthorized alien, as defined in 8 U.S.C. §1324a, if the information obtained in
- 6 accordance with the status verification system indicated that the individual's federal
- 7 <u>legal status allowed the employer to hire the employee.</u>
- 8 (5) Any person, contractor, or employer who complies with the provisions of this
- 9 Section shall not be liable, either criminally or civilly, under state law for a refusal to
- 10 <u>hire an individual if the information obtained in accordance with the status verification</u>
- 11 <u>system indicated that the individual's federal legal status was that of an unauthorized</u>
- 12 alien, as defined in 8 U.S.C. §1324a."
