## **DIGEST**

Smith (SB 87)

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the commissioner of OFI to disclose or cause the employees of the OFI to disclose records, other than criminal history record information provided to OFI by a state or federal law enforcement agency, concerning any person subject to its jurisdiction when such records are requested by another state or federal agency having authority to license or investigate such entity or person.

Effective August 15, 2011.

<u>Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection, and International Affairs to the original bill.</u>

1. Prohibits OFI from disclosing criminal history record information provided to OFI by a state or federal law enforcement agency concerning any person subject to its jurisdiction when such records are requested by another state or federal agency having authority to license or investigate such entity or person.
