## DIGEST

Mount (SB 207)

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that beginning January 1, 2013, and annually thereafter, the Department of Health and Hospitals shall submit an annual report concerning the Louisiana Medicaid Coordinated Care Program to the Senate and House committees on health and welfare which shall include certain information as provided for in <u>proposed law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires DHH to submit all quarterly reports submitted by the coordinated care networks to the Senate Committee on Health and Welfare, House Committee on Health and Welfare, Senate Committee on Finance, and the House Committee on Appropriations.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that any portion of the Louisiana Medical Assistance Program which are administered by a managed care organization or meet the definition of managed care pursuant to federal law or regulation shall sunset on December 31, 2014.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

- 4. Provides for submission of certain reports received by DHH from CCN's to certain legislative committees.
- 5. Provides that certain portions of the Louisiana Medical Assistance Program shall sunset on December 31, 2014.
