2 On page 3, at the end of line 25, insert

3 "However, the petition shall be served on the defendant as provided by law and any defendant desiring to contest the validity of the taking on the ground that 4 the property was not expropriated for a public use may file a motion to dismiss 5 6 the suit within ten days from the date the petition was served on him. He shall certify thereon that a copy thereof has been served personally or by mail on 7 8 either the plaintiff or his attorney of record in the suit. This motion shall be 9 tried contradictorily with preference to the judge alone and shall be decided 10 prior to the court's declaring the property has been taken for public purposes."
