The original instrument and the following digest, which constitutes no part of the legislative instrument, were prepared by Alan Miller.

DIGEST

Murray (SB 100)

<u>Present law</u> provides that if a potential supplier wishes to submit a request for prior approval of a particular product other than a product specified in the public contract documents, he must do so no later than seven working days prior to the opening of bids.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>, but extends the time period <u>from</u> seven <u>to</u> 14 days prior to the opening of bids for public works projects of the New Orleans Sewerage and Water Board.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
