- 9 "Section 1. RS. 47:841(B)(introductory language) is hereby enacted to read 10 as follows:
- 11 §841. Imposition of tax
- 12 There is hereby levied a tax upon the sale, use, consumption, 13 handling, or distribution of all cigars, cigarettes, and smoking and smokeless 14 tobacco, as defined herein, within the state of Louisiana, according to the 15 classification and rates hereinafter set forth:
- 16 17 B. Cigarettes. The taxes imposed by this Subsection shall be levied 18 upon each cigarette at the rates provided herein. Beginning January 1, 2012, 19 the base rates provided in this Subsection shall be adjusted annually in 20 accordance with changes in the Consumer Price Index as reported by the U.S. 21 government. The rate adjustment shall be calculated by multiplying the 22 current rate by the average positive percentage change in the index for the 23 most recent five years based on the CPI report for November of each year. In no instance shall the adjusted rate be less than the rate in effect on January 24 25 1, 2012. The secretary of the Department of Revenue shall publish the rate in the official journal of the state by February first of each year, and the rate 26 27 shall become effective on July first of that year.
