1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

In Amendment No. 4 of the set of four amendments proposed by Senator Marionneaux and
adopted by the Senate on June 7, 2011:

- On page 1, line 18, after "32(D)," insert "<u>but only after a public hearing as</u>
 provided for in Subsection C of this Section" and change "<u>an immediate</u>" to "<u>a</u>"
- 6 On page 3, after line 15, insert:

7 "C.(1) The disallowance or phase-out of any tax benefit or incentive shall 8 only become effective after review and approval by the Joint legislative Committee on the Budget at a public hearing as provided for in this Subsection. 9 10 (2) At such hearing the committee may receive testimony or reports from the division of administration, the Department of Revenue, the Legislative 11 Fiscal Office, or any interested member of the public on the impact on state 12 13 finances and on the economy of the disallowance or phase-out of the tax benefits 14 or incentives proposed to be made effective. (2) The agenda for such meeting shall contain the legal citation and a 15 brief summary of each tax benefit or incentive proposed to be approved at the 16 public meeting of the committee. The agenda for the meeting containing the 17 18 date, time and place of the meeting shall be published at least seven business days before such meeting in the state journal and shall also be posted on the 19 20 legislative web site. 21 (3) The tax benefit or incentive shall become effective on the first day of 22 the second month following the public meeting at which the tax benefit or incentive is approved, or at the time set forth in this Section, whichever is later." 23
