1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 38:2212(A)(8), relative to the letting of public contracts by the New Orleans  
3 Sewerage and Water Board; to provide for advertisement and letting of lowest  
4 responsible bidder; to provide for inclusion of addenda containing pricing  
5 information; and to provide for related matters.

6 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. R.S. 38:2212(A)(8) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

9 §2212. Advertisement and letting to lowest responsible bidder; public work;  
10 electronic bidding; participation in mentor-protégé program;  
11 exemptions

12 A. \* \* \*

13 **(8)(a) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary and in addition to**  
14 **any other requirements provided for in this Subsection, the Acknowledgment**  
15 **of Addenda of the bid form provided for in R.S. 38:2212(A)(1)(b)(ii) for the**  
16 **public bid of public works projects conducted by the New Orleans Sewerage**  
17 **and Water Board shall also include attachment of the addenda if pricing**  
18 **information is contained therein and the addenda specifies attachment.**

19 **(b) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary and in addition to any**  
20 **other requirements provided for in this Subsection, the Acknowledgment of**  
21 **Addenda of the bid form for public works projects conducted by the New**  
22 **Orleans Sewerage and Water Board shall also include attachment of the**  
23 **addenda if pricing information is contained therein and the addenda specifies**  
24 **attachment.**

26 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not

1 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature  
2 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If  
3 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become  
4 effective on the day following such approval.
