Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 47:463.152, relative to motor vehicle special prestige license plates; to provide
3	for the creation, issuance, and design of such license plates; to provide relative to
4	the fee and distribution of fees for such plates; to authorize the promulgation of rules
5	and regulations; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 47:463.152 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§463.152. Special prestige license plate; "Feeding Hope"
9	A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall
10	establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the "Feeding
11	Hope" plate, provided there is a minimum of one thousand applicants for such plates.
12	These license plates shall be restricted to use on passenger cars, pickup trucks,
13	recreational vehicles, and vans.
14	B. The secretary shall design the plates, which shall be of a color and design
15	selected by the Louisiana Food Bank Association, Incorporated, provided that it is
16	in compliance with R.S. 47:463(A)(3).
17	C. The prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any citizen
18	of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.
19	D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars,
20	which shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This fee
21	shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article VII,
22	Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars and
23	fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of
24	administrative costs.

E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded to the Louisiana Food Bank Association, Incorporated, or its successor organization.

The monies received from the royalty fees shall be used solely for the purposes of funding nonprofit efforts.

F. The secretary shall adopt rules and regulations as are necessary to implement the provisions of this Section.
