

Existing law provides that if a member of the La. National Guard dies while serving in federal active duty service or in combat, his surviving spouse and children shall be eligible to enroll in an institution of higher education in this state and shall be exempt from tuition charges.

New law retains existing law and extends the exemption to a spouse and children of members killed while serving in state active duty.

Effective August 15, 2011.
