<u>Existing law</u>, relative to the Public Bid Law, authorizes the following public entities to utilize the design-build method in the construction or repair of any public building or structure which was destroyed or damaged by Hurricane Katrina, Hurricane Rita, or both; the division of administration; the Recovery School District; the city of New Orleans; and parish governments in Calcasieu, Cameron, Jefferson, Orleans, Plaquemines, St. Bernard, St. Tammany, and Vermilion parishes; and the Port of New Orleans.

<u>Prior law</u> provided that the authority granted in <u>existing law</u> extended for five years from July 10, 2007, which time only those projects that were contracted for prior to such termination date may proceed.

<u>New law</u> extends the length of time <u>from</u> four years <u>to</u> five years for the utilization of the design-build method for projects of certain parishes or entities under <u>existing law</u>.
