Willmott (HB 583) Act No. 202

<u>New law</u> prohibits the installation upon or as part of the equipment of a motor vehicle, any head lamp, auxiliary or fog lamp, rear lamp, signal lamp, or reflector, or parts of any of the foregoing, which tend to change the original design or performance, unless the lamp or parts of the lamp is in compliance with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No.108, as adopted by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA).

<u>New law</u> prohibits the operation of a motor vehicle equipped with any head lamp, auxiliary or fog lamp, rear lamp, signal lamp, or reflector, or parts of any of the foregoing, which tend to change the original design or performance, unless the lamp or parts of the lamp is in compliance with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No.108, as adopted by the NHTSA.

<u>New law</u> prohibits an official inspection station from issuing an official certificate of inspection to the driver of a motor vehicle that is in violation of <u>proposed law</u>.

New law provides for a \$50 fine for a 1st violation and an additional \$25 fine for each subsequent violation.

Effective August 15, 2011.
