6	Section 1. R.S. 47:305.59 and 337.9(D)(27) are hereby amended and reenacted to

8	§305.59. Exemption; charitable residential construction
9	The sales and use tax imposed by the state of Louisiana and all of its tax
10	authorities shall not apply to the sale of construction materials to Habitat for
11	Humanity affiliates, or Fuller Center for Housing covenant partners located in this
12	state, or the Make it Right Foundation when such materials are intended for use
13	in constructing new residential dwellings in this state.

22	Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2012; if vetoed by the
23	governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective

on July 1, 2012, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
