## Austin Badon (HB 191)

<u>Existing law</u> (for purposes of licensing by the Board of Regents) defines the term "proprietary school" to mean any for profit or nonprofit business enterprise which maintains a place of business in La., or which sells or offers for sale any course of instruction in the state, either by correspondence using the mails or by any other means of communication, or by personal solicitation, and which offers or maintains a course or courses of instruction or study, or at which place of business such a course or courses of instruction or study is available through classroom or Internet instruction, or both, to one or more persons for the purpose of training or preparing a person for a field of endeavor in a business, trade, technical, or industrial occupation, except as excluded by <u>existing law</u>.

<u>New law</u> adds as an exception to <u>existing law</u> a school or business enterprise which offers yoga teacher training.

Effective July 1, 2011.
